



IMPACT ON LONG-TERM HEALTH MANAGEMENT

- Many people delaying seeking help/treatment due to COVID-19 concerns
- Concerns about future appointments
- Lack of good/complete information is compounding this
- Disparity between the concerns & the actual experience

Psychology of being labelled vulnerable


- How safe is it to emerge from lockdown?
