

Aims of the Study

To assess the quality of cancer cure videos algorithmically recommended by TikTok.

To examine the radicalisation pathways afforded by short video platforms like TikTok.

To evaluate their potential to cause online harms.




- Simulated an individual diagnosed with cancer using TikTok to search for cancer cures.
- Searched for 'cancer cure' on the app.
- The top 50 posts that appeared for the search 'cancer cure' on TikTok's 'For You' page were collected weekly over a duration of four weeks from 29 April until 27 May 2024.
- 200 videos were transcribed, coded and thematically analysed.
