- ♡ A common treatment for cancer, using radiation to destroy DNA of cancer cells
- ♡ Often through a machine called a Linac or Linear Accelerator
- ♡ Around 50% of patients need radiotherapy
- ♡ Can cause a radiation skin reaction

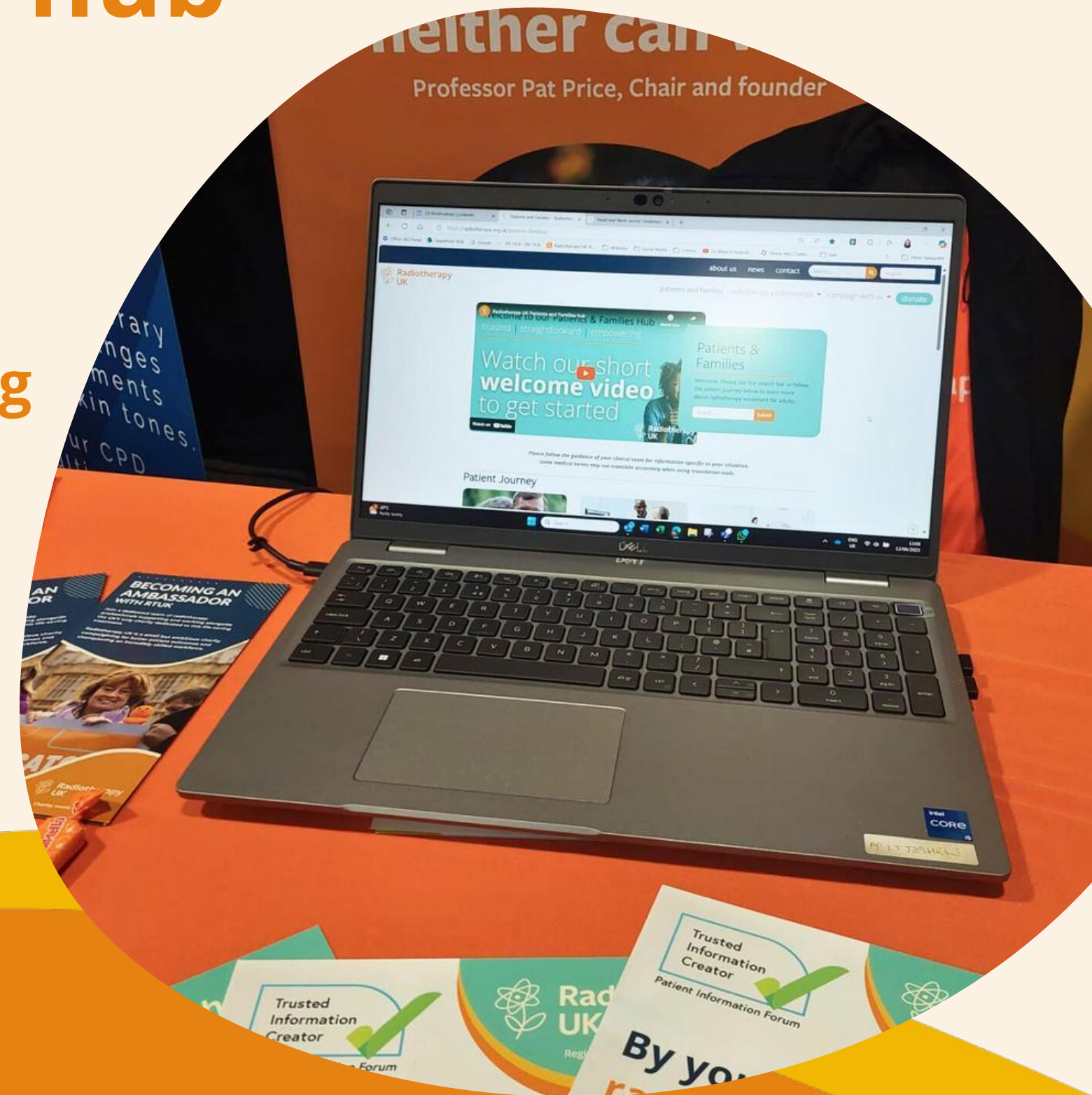
